

# Urgent Care or Emergency Room?

URGENT CARE	EMERGENCY ROOM
Pulled muscle or strain	Head or eye injuries
Minor fractures that have not broken the skin	Significant fractures that have broken the skin
Small cuts and abrasions that may require few stitches	Severe bleeding and large, open wounds
Mild asthma	Pregnancy concerns or treatment of infants
Rash	Fainting or loss of consciousness
Urinary tract infection	Sudden change in mental state
Minor abdominal pain and upset stomach	Severe abdominal pain
Vomiting and/or diarrhea	Significant burns
Cold and/or flu symptoms	Seizures without a diagnosis of epilepsy

## When should you call 9-1-1?



Shortness of breath and/or difficulty breathing



Life or limb-threatening injury



Symptoms of a heart attack such as chest pain, sudden weakness, jaw pain, arm pain or dizziness



Sign of stroke such as numbness, slurred speech, severe headache, weakness on one side or drooping of the face
